

Leadership & Complexity

Dear students,

The Edgar Morin Chair on complexity is a research and teaching chair, and proposes the curriculum « **Leadership and complexity** ».

Complexity understood as a) the intensification of contradictory logics that cross organizations in the context of the ongoing digital revolution, b) the significant increase of the uncertainty inherent to the global environment organizations, and c) the intensification of tensions in human relations given the first two points, requires indeed learning a suitable leadership. The curriculum of the chair offers some fundamental related basics.

You can validate the Program by completing the conditions indicated below:

1) Register to the 3 following compulsory courses:

- *Managing in Complexity*, given in English in Q2 and Q3 of each year,
- *Business Ethics* given in Q2 and Q3 in French (*Ethique et décision*), and in English in Q1
- *Philosophy and Trade*, given in Q2 and Q3 in French (*Philosophie et Commerce*), and in English in Q1.

3) Follow up of the chair seminar, consisting of:

- Participation in at least three activities of the chair and writing of a report about each event which you've attended,
 - Participation in research work conducted over six months, in Q2 and Q3 of each year, in collaboration with Orange, the partner of the chair.
- Being finalized, the terms of this work will be specified as soon as possible.

Therefore, with this curriculum you can validate a total of 5 UV of the ESSEC MSc.

All requirements should be fulfilled upon one full academic year only.
